Reporting to the Police

Always ring 999 in an EMERGENCY and 101 in a non-emergency.

Non-emergency crimes can also be reported online via Twitter, between 8am - 10pm by tagging or direct messaging the **Met Contact Centre**, (https://twitter.com/MetCC).

In addition, information for non-urgent crimes can be passed on to **Crimestoppers** where the report is then sent to the relevant authority who has the power to investigate the crimes. PLEASE NOTE: Crimestoppers is not an emergency service and if you see a crime taking place you should ring 999 to report it immediately.
